TRAINING TITLE **Compactor Loaders**

KEY TEACHING POINTS

DO

- Read and follow manufacturer's operating manual.
- Use the safety treads and grab handles to get on and off the loader.
- Use seat bar and fasten seat belt.
- Keep feet on the pedals when operating loader.
- Use only approved attachments and buckets.
- Keep other people away from work area.
- Carry bucket or attachments as low as possible.
- Load, unload, and turn on level ground.
- Wear hearing and head protection.
- Go Straight up and down slopes with the heavy end of the loader uphill.
- Check the following before starting the engine:
 - Fuel and oil
 - Hydraulic fluid.
 - Cooling system
 - Operator cab, seat belt and seat bar
 - Lift arm and cylinder pivot points
 - Tires

DO NOT

- Do not use loader without approved Roll-Over Protection and Falling Over Protection cab.
- Do not exceed rated operating capacity.
- Do not carry passengers.
- Do not travel or turn with lift arms up.
- Do not leave loader with engine running or with lift arms up.
- Do not go across a slope.
- Do not approach overhead wires.
