KEY TEACHING POINTS

HAZARDS

- Asphyxiation is the most common reason for death and injuries, and a hazardous atmosphere is the most common cause of asphyxiation.
- Other hazards include:
 - Toxins
 - Explosions and fires - these are often caused by hazardous atmospheres
 - Engulfment - being buried or crushed by loose material within the space
 - Being struck by falling objects
 - Heat disorders
 - Electrocution
 - Untrained rescuers
