TRAINING TITLE **Contact Dermatitis - Protect Your Skin**

KEY TEACHING POINTS

- Read labels and MSDS to identify substances that can irritate the skin.
- Take special care around skin irritants if you have any pre-existing skin condition.
- Keep skin covered on the job.
- Wear all PPE recommended by the MSDS of chemicals you work with or handle.
- Check PPE before use to be sure there are no holes or damage.
- Keep chemical containers closed when not in use.
- Cover cuts and scrapes with bandages before putting on PPE.
- Use appropriate barrier creams as protection when you can't use gloves.
- Was immediately and thoroughly after exposure to skin irritants.
- Shower after working with chemicals.
- Keep bathrooms, showers, and work areas clean.
- Put on clean outer and under layers of clothing daily.
- Wash work clothes after each use, keeping them separate from street clothes.
- Get medical attention for any symptoms of skin disease.
