TRAINING TITLE **Lift Station Maintenance - Operation and Maintenance**

KEY TEACHING POINTS

- Lift stations are permit required confined spaces. Follow confined space procedures.
- Open and ventilate before entering. Where possible use gas meter to assure it is safe to open the accessway.
- While ventilating, turn on water and flush wet well.
- Complete confined space pre-entry checklist. Get gas meter readings. Test for Oxygen content, LEL, Hydrogen Sulfide and Carbon Monoxide. If readings are unacceptable do not enter.
- Follow lockout/tagout/blockout procedures. De-energize and secure pumps before work is started.
- Personal protective equipment requirements:
 - Gas meter
 - Fall protection harness
 - Lifeline
 - Tripod with winch
- Station attendant outside lift station. Check radio to make sure it works properly.
- Monitor air every 20 minutes. If air is bad evacuate.
- Clean-up, close-down, and wash down area before departure.
- Terminate confined space permit.
