TRAINING TITLE	Materials Handling - Carboys	
KEY TEACHING POINTS		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Always assume carboys contain hazardous materials. • Wear gloves and safety shoes and any other personal protective equipment appropriate for the hazardous materials contained in the carboy. • Use special long-handled carts to pick up carboys or boxes of carboys. The handles are designed to protect workers from getting splashed in the event of leakage. • Do not stack un-boxed or un-crated carboys. • Do not stack crated or boxed carboys by more than three. 		
STORAGE		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Store corrosive materials in areas designated to contain spills and corrosive vapors. Emergency exhausts should be available in such areas. • Have absorbent and neutralizing materials available. • Know the emergency response plan. Personal protective equipment must be on hand. Training must be provided. • Use containment trays large enough to hold the contents of the carboys. Trays should be under each carboy or stack of carboys. • Store incompatible materials in separate designated areas.
