TRAINING TITLE	Materials Handling - Gas Cylinders	
KEY TEACHING POINTS		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear gloves and safety shoes. • Know the contents and their hazards before working with cylinders. • Chain, strap or otherwise restrain cylinders at all times, including transit or storage, or while manually handling. • Ensure that the valve protector cap is in place and properly screwed on, until the cylinder is to be connected. • Move cylinders using special gas cylinder carts with straps and a stable base which will remain upright if the cart is released. • Do not roll, drop, drag or slide cylinders. • Do not allow cylinders to collide. • Do not remove content label or hazardous waste warning labels. • Do not accept improperly or unclearly marked cylinders. • Do not accept damaged cylinders. • Do not rely on color coding. • Do not accept or handle cylinders that don't have a protective cap.
