<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Containers specifically designed for bulk storage of materials may be in the form of containerized pallets or steel or plastic containers. They are usually designed for bay storage and usually interlock for increased stability during stacking.</li> <li>• Inspect containers before stacking.</li> <li>• Follow the manufacturer's recommendations on the safe height of stacking.</li> <li>• Do not mix containers of different types or sizes.</li> <li>• Do not use damaged containers.</li> </ul>
