KEY TEACHING POINTS		
<b>HAZARD IDENTIFICATION</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Appearance and odor: Opaque liquid; oily odor.</li> <li>• Causes eye burns and skin irritation</li> </ul>		
<b>FIRST AID</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In case of skin contact, remove contaminated clothing without delay. Flush skin thoroughly with water. Do not reuse clothing without laundering.</li> <li>• In case of eye contact, immediately irrigate with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention without delay.</li> </ul>		
<b>PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wear eye protection (goggles or full faceshield), rubber gloves and boots, coveralls.</li> <li>• Use SCBA when exposure level is not know.</li> </ul>		
<b>CLEANING POLYMER TANK</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wear fall protection when working on elevated surfaces.</li> <li>• Wear all PPE indicated above.</li> <li>• If entry into polymer tank is required, follow confined space procedures.</li> </ul>
