**TRAINING TITLE**      Ponds

**KEY TEACHING POINTS**

Ponds of any kind present basically the same hazards. Therefore, the following safety measures will apply to ponds in general.

If it is necessary to drive a vehicle on top of the pond levees, maintain the roadway in good driving condition by surfacing it with gravel or asphalt. Do not allow chuckholes or the formation of ruts. Be extremely cautious in wet weather. The material used in the construction of most levees becomes very slippery when wet. Slippery conditions should be corrected using crushed rock or other suitable material.

Never go out on the pond for sampling or other purposes when you are by yourself.. Someone should be standing by on the bank in case you get into trouble. Always wear an approved life jacket when working from a boat or raft on the surface of the pond. And, as in any boating activity, **DO NOT STAND UP IN THE BOAT WHILE PERFORMING WORK.**
