TRAINING TITLE	Chainsaw - Personal Protective Equipment	
KEY TEACHING POINTS		
EYE PROTECTION		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear safety glasses and faceshield. • A faceshield attached to the hard hat without safety glasses does not provide the adequate eye protection. 		
GLOVES & MITTS		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leather gloves with ballistic nylon reinforcement on the back. They offer a good grip on the saw, protect the hands and absorb some vibration. 		
FOOT PROTECTION		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Heavy, well-fitted safety work boots. • Boots made of ballistic nylon offer the best cut protection. • Rubber soles for wet weather and snow, and hobnail boots, grip soles or cork soles for rough terrain. 		
HEAD PROTECTION		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High visibility hard hat. 		
HEARING PROTECTION		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ear plugs or muffs. Chain saws create high noise levels in the range 95 - 115 dBA. 		
LEG PROTECTION		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trousers or chaps with sewn-in ballistic nylon pads. • Close fitting clothing without cuffs, made of close-woven fabrics.
