**TRAINING TITLE**      **Fence and Backstop Repair**

**KEY TEACHING POINTS**

**HAZARDS**

- Moving traffic
- Loose ends of wire and fabric
- Overcrowding of workers
- Starting of fires
- Slip, trip, and fall hazards

**PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**

- Leather gloves
- Eye protection
- Safety shoes/boots

**SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURES**

- Review safe practice rules for applicable equipment (including rental equipment and perform pre-operational checks.
- Review work area protection procedures and any traffic control requirements.
- Park in an area suitable for safe entering or exiting of vehicle which does not cause a hazard to yourself or others.
- While on foot, make every effort to perform your work facing oncoming traffic.
- Employee shall select proper tools for the job.
- Allow ample space for each employee to work safely.
- Be alert to wire and posts which are under tension.
- Clear work area of fire hazards before using a torch.
- Watch for tripping hazards and uneven ground.
- Have a fire extinguisher available while cutting or welding.
