KEY TEACHING POINTS		
<p>Working around and on cyclone grit separators requires the exercise of extreme caution. Always shut off, lockout and tagout equipment before attempting to remove objects causing stoppages or to work on the equipment.</p> <p>Slowly moving screw conveyors and other equipment can seriously injure you by crushing or tearing your hand or leg. Lifting of heavy cyclone parts is very difficult and can cause injuries resulting from sprains or strains if you are not careful. Be careful on slippery surfaces because a fall may result in a serious injury.</p> <p>Fall protection is required if you are working over six feet from the surface below.</p> <p>The interior is a confined space.</p>
